



TRIC COMPENSATION and PRODUCTION TRENDS


The employer portion of benefit costs for physicians was stable after two years of decreases. 2023 total benefits averaged \$47,660 or 17.7% of total compensation. The cost of benefits is variable across pediatric specialty categories, with primary care physicians having the lowest benefit expenses and surgical physicians having the highest.
